

In-Patient Department, AIIMS Bibinagar

In the midst of unprecedented challenges posed by COVID-19 pandemic, the In-Patient Department (IPD) at AIIMS Bibinagar emerged as a beacon of hope and resilience, embodying the institution's commitment to excellence in healthcare delivery. What began as a modest endeavor with 30-50 beds during the second wave of COVID-19 in April 2021, swiftly evolved into a cornerstone of medical care, catering to a diverse range of specialties and serving as a testament to the dedication and ingenuity of its staff.

On July 1st, 2021, a significant milestone was achieved with the inauguration of a 100-bed IPD in C block, AIIMS, Bibinagar, symbolizing a leap forward in the institution's capacity to provide comprehensive in-patient care. This expansion marked a pivotal moment in AIIMS Bibinagar's journey, enabling it to offer specialized treatment across various medical disciplines, from internal medicine and surgery to pediatrics, obstetrics, and gynecology, ophthalmology, otolaryngology etc.

However, the pursuit of excellence knows no bounds, and AIIMS Bibinagar continued to strive for greater heights. Despite facing logistical challenges due to ongoing construction and renovation work, the IPD underwent a seamless transition to B block in November 2023. This relocation not only facilitated the expansion of bed capacity to 130 but also paved the way for the introduction of super-specialty in-patient services, further enhancing the institution's ability to address complex medical conditions with precision and expertise. In fact the IPD services had had more than 10,000 admissions since its inception.

IPD was running with 14 departments at the starting of financial year 23-24 and later it increased to 19. Specialties like neonatology, urology, burns and plastic surgery also started the In-Patient services. Total new admissions during FY 23- 24 were 2775. It increased to 5477. That shows increase in the rate of admission to 197 %. During April 2023, the bed occupancy rate was 33%. This was increased to 63% in March 2024.

In December 2023 the entire IPD was shifted to second floor H & G block. That time we are able to increase the bed strength from 100 to 156. IPD conducted several training programme for the newly joined NORCET 4 and NORCET 5 nursing officers during January to march 2024. We have received 5 multipara monitors and 2 ICU monitors during this time. And we are able to set up one High Dependency Unit of 11 beds with monitors in all beds. We are able to set up one separate post op area with 16 beds for aseptic management of all the post op patients.

Central to the success of the IPD at AIIMS Bibinagar is its unwavering commitment to evidence-based practice and cost-effective healthcare solutions. By leveraging the latest advancements in medical science and technology, coupled with a judicious utilization of resources, the department ensures that patients receive the highest standard of care without imposing financial burdens. This approach not only promotes efficiency but also fosters equitable access to healthcare, empowering individuals from all walks of life to avail of world-class medical treatment.
