

AIIMS, Bibinagar starts Mobile Medical Unit services in Indriyala village.

Inauguration of Mobile Medical Unit services at Indriyala village, Medical health camp & Plastic free environment campaign at Zilla Parishad High School Including six Village adoption so far by AIIMS Bibinagar

Mobile Medical Unit (MMU) services was started on 7th April, 2022 by AIIMS Bibinagar with an objective of reaching the unreached. On 17th November as an extension of this programme, Indriyala village of Yadadri-Bhongiri district has been adopted (so far six village adopted) by the institution for providing health care services.

Inaugurating the MMU services at Indriyala village Prof Dr. Vikas Bhatia, Executive Director, AIIMS Bibinagar expressed his desire to develop Indriyala Village as a Model Village, in the presence of Dean Dr. Rahul Narang, Medical Superintendent Dr. Neeraj Agarwal, Sarpanch Mrs. Alivelu, MPTC Mr. Yadgiri, Upsarpanch Mr. Sai, Village Secretary Mr. Shiva Kumar and faculty of Community and Family Medicine Department.

An awareness programme on plastic free environment was conducted by the medical students in the Zilla Parishad High School and jute bags were distributed to students to signify the beginning of a change.

A medical camp was conducted in which 128 patients were examined, blood pressure and , free blood tests were carried out and medicines were distributed. Till date, more than 3000 patients in underserved communities have been catered to by the MMU.
