

Institution Research Cell conducts Basic Research Methodology workshop for Junior Residents (Acad) at AIIMS, Bibinagar

The participants included JRs from the departments of Anatomy, Biochemistry, Physiology, Forensic Medicine, Microbiology, Pathology, Pharmacology and Community Medicine and Family Medicine. Day 3 (17.03.2022): The pre-decided groups of JRs prepared and presented draft research protocols which were attended by all the resource faculty members, who provided their valuable feedback on important aspects of the protocol.
