

AIIMS Bibinagar Sets Up 10 Bed ICU Units for COVID

The Second Wave of COVID created an unprecedented shortage of ICU beds all over India. As a means of preparedness for the 3rd wave, AIIMS Bibinagar, under the leadership of Executive Director Dr Vikas Bhatia, drafted a plan of action to create the best ICU setup through CSR and Govt Support.

Compassionate Pandemic Response group stepped forward to work with AIIMS Bibinagar in setting up a world-class 10-bedded ICU with high-end ICU beds, ventilators, monitors, defibrillator, Ultrasound machine with 2D-Echo and Dialysis machine.

This ICU is the first of its kind in India with an HVAC system having 100% HEPA-filtered fresh air without recycling, leaving no chance for hospital-acquired infection.

This facility is flexible to convert from positive pressure ventilation to negative pressure isolation ICU when required, such as in the requirement of COVID-19 isolation.

A Pooja ceremony was performed during the auspicious time of Dussehra, which was graced by Prof. Vikas Bhatia, Director, AIIMS Bibinagar, Dr Neeraj Agarwal, MS, Dr Nitin John, Officiating Dean, Col. S P Ananthrao, Deputy Director Admin along with Dr Satya Garimella, Mr Uday Kumar, Mr Krishna kottapalli, from the CPR team.

After validation and microbiological clearance, it will provide quality medical care to both COVID and non-COVID critical cases and immensely benefit the people of Telangana in the near future.
