

**“Vertigo and Imbalance: Path to Equilibrium” Conducted by

The Department of Otorhinolaryngology and Head and Neck Surgery of AIIMS, Bibinagar organized a two-day CME on the 20th and 21st Sept 2021, on “ Vertigo and Imbalance: Path to Equilibrium” on the occasion of BALANCE AWARENESS WEEK which is observed globally between 19th – 25thth Sept. 
